

Visual Schedule Instructions

- A visual schedule can be represented in a number of ways: photographs, line drawing, symbols, or text.
- Tasks are represented in the order in which they are to be completed.
- We recommend cutting out each pictured icon and laminating it for repeated use.
- Using the blank schedules, you can create a list of activities for your child to complete for morning, afternoon, and evening.
- Once your child has completed each activity, he/she can move the activity from the "To Do" side of the schedule to the "Done" side of the schedule to support him/her in knowing what has been completed and what activity will be next.
